5. Entry Requirements

5.1. General Foundation Program:

5.2. Academic Programs at Undergraduate Levels:

5.3. Exemptions:

- A prospective student who has an IELTS Score 5.0 or above or its equivalent will be exempted from GFP English Courses
- * A prospective student with IC3 in English Language or ICDL or Cambridge Diploma will be exempted from Computing Skills requirements at GFP.

5.4. Academic Programs at Postgraduate Levels:

- * Bachelor degree or equivalent with accumulative GPA 2.5 out of 4.
- * Diploma degree with accumulative GPA 2.5 out of 4 and 6 years' work experience in relevant field (For Human Resources Management program);

- Original transcripts from previous institute/s attended.
- * All official academic transcripts and certificates must be attested/legalized by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Embassy of the Sultanate of Oman from the applicant's home country. The admission will be confirmed after equalization of the certificates by Ministry of Higher Education, Sultanate of Oman.

- * Copy of a valid passport (Valid for at least 6 months).
- * Two recent passport size photos.
- Visa application fees 33 OMR (Subject to change based on Immigration Laws and Policies).

10.2. About Sur City:

Located on the coast of the Arabian Sea and Gulf of Oman, Sur City has beautiful beaches and resorts. Ras Al Hadd and Ras Al Jinz beaches are to name a few.
